## Continuing Education Credits

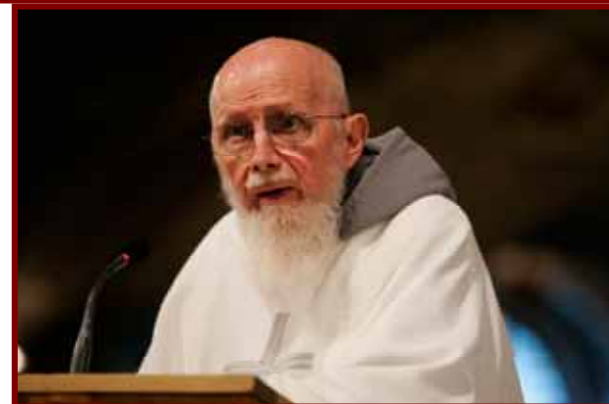

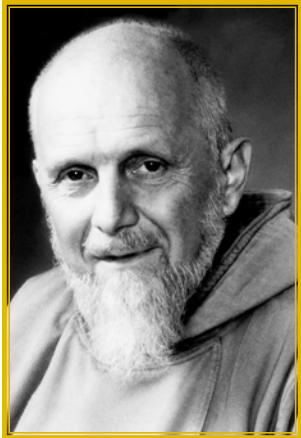

Management from a Christian  
Perspective*

### 27.5 CE Credits

*Dates:* Tuesday, May 27-Friday, May 30, 2007

*Hours:* Mon-Thurs: 9-12, 2-5, and 7-8:30

Friday: 9-12, 2-5

The course focuses on the practical assistance of persons experiencing trauma, extreme stress and sorrow. Resources are drawn from appropriate Christian literature, as well as contemporary literature on crisis management. The course also serves as a model for integrating religious values with counseling and psychotherapy.

### Course Objectives:

1. To gain an understanding of the nature of stress and crisis and how they affect persons.
2. To gain an understanding of how to assess stress and crisis levels within clients' lives.
3. To gain introductory knowledge of a variety of interventions for use with clients who are experiencing a variety of types of stress and crises.
4. To develop an integrated Christian understanding of the experience of crisis and ways of working with clients.
5. To develop a repertoire of crisis intervention skills through in-class practice and role-playing.
