Scrofani, P. Development of the Person Scale (in preparation for journal submission: This is an original index for the assessment of interpersonal behavior. The initial pilot study includes the administration of the Person Scale along with four other scales for validation purposes and additional administrations for reliability studies. Data collection began September, 2007 and was completed in 2009. Data analysis is completed. Preparation of manuscript is underway.

John W. Stiller, J.W., Scrofani, P., Guzman, A... & Pannella, P. (In progress) A Prospective Study of Early Indicators of Dementia Pugilistic. (The study has been sanctioned by the Maryland State Boxing Commission and dialogue is taking place with the D.C. Boxing Commission. This is the first longitudinal study of dementia pugilistica ever done. It is currently in progress and the team has enrolled and assessed over 200 boxers during preflight medical examinations and the sample is growing. We have also begun 12 month follow-up assessments. Follow-up is planned over a five to ten year period.)
